

Waste Management in the Township of Lake of Bays

What are the weekly garbage bag limits and tipping fees?

Residents in the Township of Lake of Bays can deliver three (3) bags of household waste and unlimited sorted recycling each week at any waste facility in Muskoka at no charge.

The facility site attendant will record license plates upon arrival for tracking purposes. Specific addresses may be requested for data tracking purposes.

In addition to weekly limits of household garbage - leaves, scrap metal, appliances (without freon), and tires are also accepted at no charge.

I own multiple properties, what am I entitled to at waste facilities?

Residents in the Township of Lake of Bays who own more than one property are entitled to increased bag limits. Upon approval by the District, a customer number will be created to ensure a convenient and efficient process upon your arrival at the waste facility each week.

To arrange an account, a Waste Consolidation Application will need to be completed by the property owner.

You will require the following information for the application:

- property owner name and contact information
- 19-digit property roll number(s) of property
- the license plate number of vehicle(s) that will be transporting waste
- preferred /most commonly used waste facility location
