Milkweed is the only plant Monarch caterpillar's eat

Monarchs lay their eggs on the milkweed plant and the larvae consume the leaves providing nourishment for them to transform into adult butterflies.

The Township of Lake of Bays is encouraging our residents to plant milkweed seeds on their properties in the Fall to help the Monarch butterfly population.
